IRVINE, CA—R.D. Olson Development has completed construction of the 210-room Courtyard by Marriott here.

The eight-story hotel, which was designed by WATG, has officially opened and represents the Southern California debut of Marriott's latest Gen Next design. The room mix includes 94 King beds, 14 executive corner suites and 102 double Queen bed configurations. The hotel also offers 8,500 square feet of meeting space.
