

Two Honolulu architecture firms rank in top 100 in national revenue survey

Two Honolulu-based architecture firms with long histories in Hawaii placed in the top 100 in a recent survey of top revenue-producing firms in the U.S.

WATG ranked 55th and Architects Hawaii Ltd. ranked 90th out of 300 firms in Architectural Record's [survey of top firms](#) based on 2014 revenue.

WATG generated \$69.67 million in revenue in 2014, according to the survey. It had ranked 44th in last year's survey, based on 2013 revenue.

"Being ranked 55th among the top 300 architecture firms is a testament to our original founders who laid the pathway of our success 70 years ago here in the Islands," Managing Director [Craig Takahata](#) said in a statement.

"Although we have expanded our offices globally, our international reputation respectfully points back to Hawaii."

Architects Hawaii, which was founded in 1946, generated \$28.4 million in revenue in 2014, according to the survey, jumping from 111th place the year before.

"Being listed in the country's top third of design firms says a lot about our team and the creative work we are generating for our clients," President and CEO [Bettina Mehnert](#) said in a statement. "In this competitive industry and economy, it is encouraging that Architects Hawaii is doing so well on a national level."
