The transformation of the guestrooms is part of the hotel’s overall \$115 million redevelopment that will see it re-emerge in fall 2017 as ‘Alohilani Resort’ at Waikiki Beach, an entirely new and exciting Waikiki Beach destination resort. The guestrooms are being designed with a contemporary flair, blending distinctive Hawaiian style with a modern beach house ambiance. Managed by [Highgate](#), the hotel will remain fully operational during all phases of construction and guests can already experience the redesigned guest rooms and suites that recently debuted.

Residence Inn by Marriott, Wailea

An integrated design project by WATG’s Honolulu and Irvine studios, the recently opened [Residence Inn by Marriott Wailea](#) is an extended-stay property featuring resort-like amenities that provide guests with the convenience and comfort to live like a local. The Landscape has been designed to line the entry drive with a variety of royal palms, leading you up Wailea Iki Drive, setting the scene from the arrival. Upon entering the open-air lobby in the 200-room, four-story Residence Inn, guests are immediately greeted and immersed with the beauty of Wailea with views of the Pacific Ocean. The Residence suites, ranging in size from one-bedroom to two-bedrooms, open to expansive views of the ocean or mountainside. The

stylish and modern suites come fully equipped with kitchens, functional work spaces, and generous balconies.

Four Seasons Resort, Maui
